## Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Les

Champs Gain, 2015, Marc Colin

125ml - £27

Bottle - £165

The 2015 vintage has a little more precision on the nose compared to the Chevevottes, with a hint of star anise in the background. The palate is fresh and vibrant on the entry with lemon zest and orange zest notes, a fine line of acidity and a gentle build towards a satisfying and harmonious finish

## Margaux (Grand Cru Classé), 2013

Château Kirwan

125ml - £23

Bottle - £128

The wine's deep and brilliant ruby red colour reflects a nose of black and red berries, cherry, black currant, blueberry, enhanced by aromas of spices, pink peppercorns and vanilla. This vintage has a strikingly tactile quality; it starts out mellow, then offers the taste buds a rich body, with nearly imperceptible tannins and an acidity that perfectly balances out its silky texture.

## Antinori - Tenuta Tignanello :

Tignanello 2015

125ml - £32.50

Bottle - £230

Rich, black cherry fruit from the Sangiovese dominating the nose. Potent and powerful with hints of graphite in the background. Full-bodied and savoury on the palate with dark cherry fruit again. Mouth-watering acidity gives away its Chianti Classico roots, while soft, fine tannins complete the picture. Fabulous balance and a long, elegant finish rounds off this great Tignanello.
